## CLOTHING:

- Class-A Boy Scout Uniform

## LEAVE AT HOME:

Pets, sheath knives, fireworks, firearms, ammunition, bows & arrows, televisions, squirt guns, un scout-like literature, alcoholic beverages, and illegal drugs are not permitted in camp. Valuable items should be left at home.

## LABEL GEAR:
